

Request for Proposals International Travel Grants

Deadlines: October 1, 2014 March 2, 2015

The Duke Global Health Institute (DGHI) is pleased to offer international travel awards of up to \$5000 each to Duke faculty to pursue global health research opportunities in low- or middle-income countries (please see World Bank list). These awards are aimed at faculty looking to explore new research collaborations by visiting an international site. Applications will be reviewed on a biannual schedule, and should include a brief description of proposed activities (no more than 3 pages), budget, and applicant's CV or NIH biosketch. Applications should emphasize the relationship of the proposal to DGHI's Research Priorities, and the prospects for longer-term external research funding support. Proposals will be reviewed by DGHI internal and external reviewers.

Eligibility: Proposals must be submitted by Duke faculty. Proposals from junior faculty and those who have never received a DGHI travel grant will be given priority in review.

Proposal due dates: October 1 and March 2 Funding award dates: October 31 and April 1
