Summary:

The position will assist in multiple areas of PI's academic efforts; including research projects, journal publications, seeking research grants and other dissemination activities. The tasks will include analysis of empirical data for research projects and journal publications, literature review, preparation of manuscript drafts, assistance with proposal development and grant applications, and assisting with quantitative methods. The fields of research are in the areas of health services & systems, policy research and health economics. Areas of research include population aging & chronic diseases, comparative health policy analysis and econometric methods in health services research.
