

## Duke Master of Science in Global Health Application Fee Waiver

The Duke Global Health Institute (DGHI) offers an application fee waiver option to support prospective students who may be experiencing economic stresses.

### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to request an application fee waiver, you must

- A) Be a citizen from an LMIC (as defined by [The World Bank](#)),
- B) Be in good academic standing,
- C) Demonstrate high financial need.

### REQUESTING A WAIVER

DGHI is able to offer a limited number of application fee waivers during the 2023-24 application cycle. Fee waiver applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, so prospective applicants are encouraged to apply early.

### Important reminders

- You will not be able to request an application fee waiver unless you meet the eligibility requirements outlined above.
- Application fees will not be reimbursed if payment has been provided.
- A candidate's eligibility for admission will not be impacted by a request for or receipt of a fee waiver.
- Students who receive application fee waivers are expected to submit their graduate application by the priority application deadline of January 15, 2024.

### Steps for requesting a waiver

1. Review the eligibility requirements above prior to applying.
