



Request for Proposals Global Health Travel Grants

**Application Deadline:
December 4, 2023**

The Duke Global Health Institute (DGHI) is pleased to offer travel awards of up to \$5000 each to regular rank Duke faculty to pursue global health research opportunities in low, lower- and upper- middle-income countries (a listing of eligible countries can be found at the World Bank [website](#)) OR focused on health disparities in the American South. These awards are aimed at faculty looking to explore new collaborations by conducting a site visit.

[If you do not plan to visit an LMIC, please contact Kelly Deal before submitting your proposal.]

Applications should include a brief description of proposed activities (no more than 3 pages), budget and brief justification (1 page), and applicant's CV or NIH biosketch. Applications should emphasize the relationship of the proposal to specific goals of building partnerships and research collaborations and the prospects for longer-term external research funding support. Budget cannot be used for conference travel, faculty salary, or indirects. Expenses, such as travel for study team members, are allowed when justified by proposed activities.

Eligibility: Proposals must be submitted by regular rank Duke Faculty. Proposals from junior faculty and those who have never received a DGHI travel grant will be given priority in review.

Proposal due dates: December 4, 2023 or earlier

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. If you wish to travel soon, you can submit earlier for an earlier decision.
