Global Health Travel Grants**

**Application Deadline:
October 31, 2022**

The Duke Global Health Institute (DGHI) is pleased to offer travel awards of up to \$5000 each to Duke faculty to pursue global health research opportunities in low, lower- and upper- middle-income countries (a listing of eligible countries can be found at the World Bank [website](#)) OR focused on health disparities in the American South. These awards are aimed at faculty looking to explore new collaborations by conducting a site visit.

[If you do not plan to visit an LMIC, please contact Kelly Deal before submitting your proposal.]

Applications should include a brief description of proposed activities (no more than 3 pages), budget, and applicant's CV or NIH biosketch. Applications should emphasize the relationship of the proposal to specific goals of building partnerships and research collaborations and the prospects for longer-term external research funding support. Budget cannot be used for conference travel, but can be provided for study team members if appropriate for the proposed activities.

Eligibility: Proposals must be submitted by Duke Faculty. Proposals from junior faculty and those who have never received a DGHI travel grant will be given priority in review.

Proposal due dates: October 31, 2022 or earlier

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis. If you wish to travel soon, you can submit earlier for an earlier decision.
