



Request for Proposals International Travel Grants

**Application Deadline:

The Duke Global Health Institute (DGHI) is pleased to offer international travel awards of up to \$5000 each to DGHI faculty to pursue global health research opportunities in low- or middle-income countries (please see [World Bank](#) list). These awards are aimed at faculty looking to explore new research collaborations by visiting an international site. Applications will be reviewed on a biannual schedule, and should include a brief description of proposed activities (no more than 3 pages), budget, and applicant's CV or NIH biosketch. Applications should emphasize the relationship of the proposal to DGHI's [Research Priorities](#), and/or [Priority Partnership Locations](#), and the prospects for longer-term external research funding support. With a goal to diversify research activities in Cape Town and Peru, review priority will be given to applicants who wish to travel to those sites.

Eligibility: Proposals must be submitted by DGHI Faculty or Affiliates. Proposals from junior faculty and those who have never received a DGHI travel grant will be given priority in review.

Proposal due dates: October 16, 2017

Funding award dates: November 6, 2017
